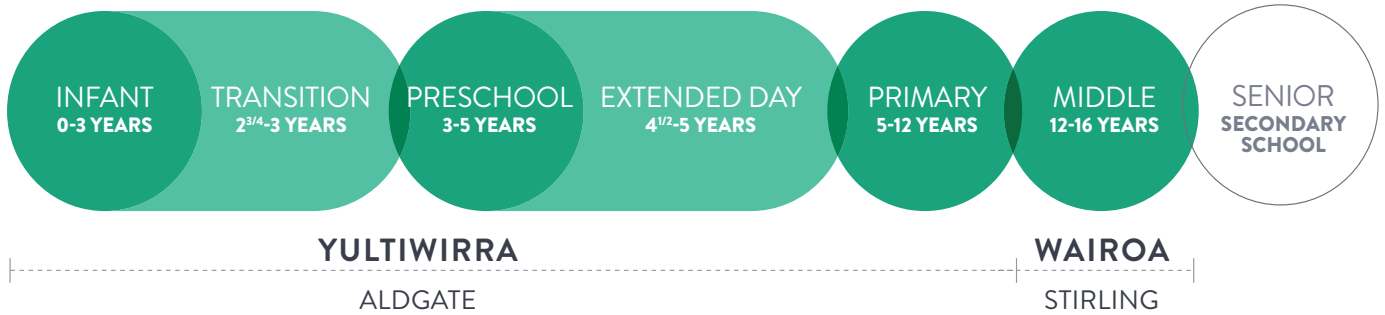


OUR PROGRAMS | FROM 0-16 YEARS



New students may join the school at any stage, subject to vacancies. The school enrolment policy & procedures will be followed.

INFANT PROGRAM | 0-3 YEARS

SESSION TIMES

MON 9.30 – 11.00AM
TUES 9.30 – 11.00AM
FRI 9.30 – 11.00AM

- An Infant Program Registration Form needs to be completed for all children attending, regardless of age.
- Payment of a term's fee is required prior to commencing in the Infant Program.
- Children must attend the session with a parent or caregiver.
- A place in the 0-3 Infant Program does not automatically secure a place in The Hills Montessori School Preschool Transition, Preschool or Primary School program. The normal application and enrolment procedures apply.
- A child's place in Infant Program rolls over from term to term until parents advise any change. Once offered a place in the Infant Program, a child's place is secure and a payment of a term's fee is required prior to starting each term.

TRANSITION PROGRAM | 2³/₄-3 YEARS

SESSION TIMES:

WED | 9.30-12PM
THE LAST 4 WEEKS OF EACH TERM

- Children can attend the Transition Program the term before they turn 3 years old.
- Children must attend the session with a parent or caregiver.
- The Transition Program is held in the Preschool facilitated by a Preschool staff member.
- A Transition Program Registration Form needs to be completed for children attending the Transition Program.
- A place in the Transition Program does not automatically secure a place in The Hills Montessori School Preschool or Primary School program. The normal application and enrolment procedures apply.

PRESCHOOL PROGRAM | 3-5 YEARS

3-4¹/₂ YEARS

SESSION TIMES:

MON, TUES & WED | 9.15-12PM
OR
THURS & FRI | 9.15-12PM

- Children must be 3 years old and toilet trained to attend the Preschool program.
- Children can attend Preschool three mornings a week (Mon - Wed) or two mornings a week (Thurs / Fri).
- An Application Form and the Application Fee needs to be completed and paid to confirm your interest in joining the school.
- When a place is available, a letter of offer will be sent to the family along with the Enrolment Agreement. An interview between the Principal, parent and student will be arranged. An Enrolment Fee and Bond will be payable at this time.

EXTENDED PROGRAM

4¹/₂-5 YEARS

SESSION TIMES:

MON, TUE, THU, FRI | 9.15-2.30PM
WED | 9.15-12.00PM

- Additional procedures are followed for Students with Disabilities/Learning Difficulties.
- Preschool children are offered a place in the Extended Program when they demonstrate developmental readiness.
- Extended Program students are automatically offered a place in the primary school.
- Afternoon child care is available to enrolled Preschool students on the days that they attend.

PRIMARY PROGRAM | 5-12 YEARS

STUDENTS ATTEND:

MON-FRI | 9AM – 3.30PM

- The application and enrolment process as explained above are followed for new families to the school at the Primary level.
- Additional procedures are followed for Students with Disabilities/Learning Difficulties.
- Before and After School Care as well as Vacation Care is offered to Preschool and Primary school students.

ADOLESCENT PROGRAM | 12-16 YEARS

STUDENTS ATTEND:

MON-FRI | 8.45AM-3.30PM
Optional late afternoon sessions:
MON & TUES 3.30-5PM

- Primary students are automatically offered a place in the Adolescent Program.
- New students and families will complete the enrolment package for an external student which comprises of five components.
- An interview between the student, parent and Adolescent Program selection panel will be arranged.
- On successful completion of the enrolment process a letter of offer will be sent.
- School Enrolment Procedures will be followed.
- Additional procedures are followed for Students with Disabilities/Learning Difficulties.
